

PEACH PRESERVE, GUEMES ISLAND

VISITOR GUIDELINES

- Pets must be leashed at all times
- Harvesting of plants, animals, driftwood, firewood, and other natural objects is prohibited except by special permission
- Do not feed or approach wildlife
- Hike on established footpaths and respect surrounding private property
- No camping allowed
- · Pack out all garbage including food and pet waste
- No firearms or hunting allowed
- No bicycles allowed

ACCESSING THE PEACH PRESERVE

SJPT's Peach Preserve is located on Guemes Island, west of the ferry terminal. From the ferry landing, head north on Guemes Island Road and take a left on S. Shore Drive. The road makes a left hand bend. At the next right-hand bend there is a small pull-out area on the left (south) side of road. The entrance to the preserve is here, and marked by a sign a few feet into the forest interior.
